Where we are at.....



## Police per 1000 residents

- ❑ National 2.2
- ❑ LVMPD 1.8 (265 needed to achieve 2.0)
- ❑ Average annual increase of residents 34,000
- ❑ Tourist's not part of formula (6% of work tasks)



# Current Calls for Police Services

- ❑ Total CFS on Strip 2015 - 70,751
- ❑ Total CFS on Fremont Street 2015  
(Main - 15<sup>th</sup> St / Ogden to Carson) - 25,884
- ❑ 6% increase year over year



## Current Staffing on Strip (CCAC)

- ❑ Total Officers Assigned - 153
- ❑ Total Detectives Assigned – 20
- ❑ Average officers assigned per shift 25  
(10% vacancy included)
- ❑ Safe Strip (May – Sept) – 60 additional officers  
(1 shift)



## Current Staffing DTAC/Fremont

- ❑ Total Officers Assigned - 150
- ❑ Total Detectives Assigned – 16
- ❑ Average Officers on Fri/Sat Nights  
(Main – 6<sup>th</sup> Street / Ogden - Carson)
  - ❑ Friday-14
  - ❑ Saturday-6

# Comparable Cities

- New Orleans – Bourbon Street
  - 9.5m Visitors per year
  - 100 Officers assigned (during peak hours)
  - 1.2 miles
- New York City - Time Square
  - 100m Visitors per year
  - 100 Officers assigned ( 24 hrs per day )
  - Approximately 5 City Blocks
- L.V. BLVD. – 4.5 Miles Long
